This class is the first of many events occurring throughout today’s church to commemorate the sesquicentennial anniversary of the Reorganized Church of Jesus Christ of Latter Day Saints, now known as the Community of Christ. Rather than providing a broad chronological survey of the entire church story in just a few short hours participants will explore what caused the need for “reorganization” and the movement’s evolution to the present. It is clear that the first generation of Reorganized Church members intended to retain their original identity by keeping cherished beliefs and practices while cleansing it from the numerous perceived heresies that had crept into their midst. Over time however their church would gain its own identity. By applying sound historical methodology to understand the thoughts and actions of the Reorganized Church leaders and members new insights emerge that demonstrate the joys and struggles of a people on an exciting journey to community. That same journey continues today.
